D	<p>WARRIORS AT BROOKWOOD 10 APRIL 2019 11.00 am</p>	<p>Tour of Brookwood Military Cemetery, adjacent to Brookwood Cemetery which was opened in 1854, built by the London Necropolis Company which had its own terminus at Waterloo where funeral services could be held. In 1917 an area to the north of the cemetery was set aside for men and women of Commonwealth forces who died, many of battle wounds, in the London district. The site was further extended to accommodate Commonwealth casualties of the Second World War. Located on A324 from the village of Pirbright GU24 0JB.
